The workshop will be held in Jerusalem on Nov 3-10, 2025.

While focusing on researchers and teachers of higher education, the organizers seek a broad spectrum of professionals from various research disciplines, such as but not limited to history, ethnography, culture, arts, and demography who are interested in engaging in research, developing their teaching curricula, and including the above-mentioned topics into their classes and research interests.
