Research Workshop: 1700 Years Since Empress Helena's Visit to Jerusalem

11.3.2026, at Yad Ben-Zvi, 14 Ibn Gabirol St., Jerusalem



The Institute for the Study of the Land of Israel at Yad Yitzhak Ben-Zvi, in cooperation with the Israel Antiquities Authority, the Ingeborg Rennert Center for Jerusalem Studies at Bar-Ilan University, and the delegation excavating the Church of the Holy Sepulchre on behalf of the Sapienza University of Rome, intends to hold a research workshop on the 1700th anniversary to Empress Helena's Visit to Jerusalem.

On Wednesday, March 11, 2026, a research workshop (in English) will be held to present the new findings and insights of the delegation from Sapienza University. The researchers' lectures will be accompanied by responses from Israeli scholars followed by an open discussion by the participants.
